| 5 | Natural England Personal Letter  |
|   | Concerning a letter from Natural England directed toward Peter Lochrie directly.   |
|   | The letter raised strong concern over the removal of vegetation from the pool that could potentially harbour trembling sea mat. Directed toward PL in his capacity as Occupier/Tenant PL raised issue as he had been acting on behalf of the Swanpool Forum and this should be recognised by Natural England i.e. any liability should rest with the group and not himself. BT affirmed that as the legal occupier of the Pool he must give Natural England written notice before carrying out or allowing someone else to carry out an operation listed in the SSSI notification. |
|   | PL then stated that he had not been involved with the removal and issue<br>should be raised with Eco Islands directly as the responsible party. Again BT<br>affirmed that as the legal occupier, he is responsible under the Wildlife &<br>Countryside Act 1981 for consulting Natural England and obtaining Natural<br>England's written consent before listed operations are carried out. In addition<br>the feedback she had received from Eco Islands and previous Swanpool<br>Forum minutes suggested that PL had been made aware of their proposed<br>operations.            |
|   | BT agreed that there had been significant delay in responding to PL's original request for Natural England's assistance and guidance regarding the Eco Island issue, she also agreed that the letter, in view of this could have been perceived as upsetting.  |
|   | The Forum highlighted that there are obvious process issues that needs to be addressed. The roles of the forum and PL are confused and greater clarity is needed in this matter.   |
| 6 | Eco Island   |
|   | The issue regarding the Eco Island continues and there was concern<br>expressed by the forum that the matter has been on-going for almost two<br>years. The consensus of the forum was that Eco Islands had provided<br>something that was not fit for purpose and should be obliged to either replace<br>or reimburse the Forum. MR suggested that the company be contacted as per<br>the above coupled with photographic evidence.   |
|   | Motor Boat Club - raised further concern over the state of the road at the back<br>of the pool, any capital project to re-instate will need to be a combined effort<br>involving both Cornwall Council and Natural England.  |
