VISION STATEMENT

Swanpool LNR should be managed primarily to conserve its brackish lagoon and population of trembling sea-mat, and also to provide a recreational and educational resource.

OBJECTIVES

1. **C**onserve the brackish lagoon and associated habitats
2. **M**aintain and enhance the population of the trembling sea-mat and other important species.
3. **P**romote the educational and recreational use of the Reserve, ensuring compatibility with nature conservation.
4. **M**anage the Reserve effectively through the aegis of the Swanpool LNR Management Forum and the Swanpool Management Plan.
